Unfortunately, while traveling there there was an accident, Kocker explains what has transpired. We are determined not to stop with the projects.

May He continue to direct each of us as we do the duty that is on our plates.

Karuna is asking for us to pray for his area in India, they are having bad flooding. Enoch is asking for help with the printing of posters in Kenya, as is Robert in Uganda, he has just been asked to host a very large gathering. We also have several other area's of need and requests for more Ten Commandment posters.

Kocker sent this e-mail at 9:20pm Friday night (8-16-19) followed by another one:

PRAY FOR US, TEAM IN LIBERIA. A CALL THAT WOKE ME FROM SLEEP 5 MINUTES AGO SAYS OUR CREW TRAVELLING TO SINOE, THAT IS, OUTSIDE OF MONROVIA HAVE A SERIOUS ACCIDENT, NO OTHER DETAILS AS COMMUNICATION IS VERY BAD.

The other one at 9:27pm

A CALL FROM KULEE ABOUT 6 MINUTES AGO SAYS THEY HAD A SERIOUS ACCIDENT. NOTHING ELSE HAVE BEEN HEARD FROM HIM. NO OTHER DETAILS, IT IS 4:24 AM THIS SABBATH MORNING, THE NEWS GOT ME 5-6 MINUTES AGO FROM KULEE, AS THAT WAS SAID, " WE HAD A SERIOUS ACCIDENT". I AM NOT GETTING ANY OTHER THING.

This one came at 11:07 in the morning 8-17-19

I was on the site, brother, by 6:00 AM, could not attend service, it is a miracle that anyone could survive in such an accident. Patrick, I sent to the hospital, Kulee vows to continue. Thank God for his resilience, but I advised that we observe his health awhile, though he refused to return with me as other means are being worked out to send another vehicle that will convey them to Sinoe. Will send you the photos later.

My reply sent at 5:26 pm:

Praise God!! I'm so thankful it was not worse. Give my love to my brothers Patrick and Kulee. Nothing is worth them getting hurt!
The enemy is trying to stop us, by God's Grace we go forward.

Yes, thankful, brother, praise God.

Kocker sent another message at 1:25 pm today (8-18-19)

Except for Patrick, Kulee is okay and is resolved to continue, and afterwards, Patrick, if discharged, is also willing to continue.

Unfortunately, the vehicle is not insured, so what we pray for is, that the owner of the car will take them as we have paid before they boarded the vehicle. What a risk, but thank God they are alive.
